On 17th April 2018, the Authority presided over the launch of tree planting season for Lamu County at Manda Island Airstrip. The guest of honour during the event was NEMA's Director for Finance and Administration (DFA), Mr. Kennedy Ochuka who represented the Director General. He was accompanied by the Deputy Director for Enforcement, Ms. Salome Machua.

Mr. Ochuka also made a courtesy call to the Governor of Lamu County, Mr. Fahim Twaha accompanied by Ms. Salome Machua, Salim Bashir and Kahindi Yeri all from NEMA and the County Ecosystems Conservator, Mr. Maneno and the County Director of Environment and Natural Resources, County Government of Lamu, Mr. Mohammed Baishe.

During the courtesy call, Mr. Ochuka thanked the county government of Lamu for having given NEMA land that had enabled the Authority to construct a Green Point Office in the county. He also requested the governor's support in management of the environment in the county especially on the ban on use of plastic bags. The exercise involved planting of mangroves at the Manda airstrip at Manda Island.
